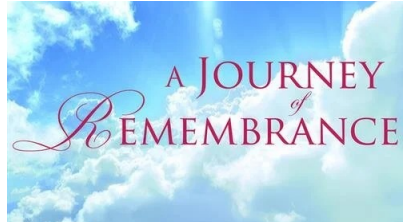

Mom was a missionary her entire life ... even though she never went to a foreign field, she always had her pockets filled with tracts or Sunday School papers, and she faithfully gave to them to every store clerk, bank clerk, etc., and during her later years when she was more confined to her home, she would give one to every Meals on Wheels person who came with deliveries to her apartment. If

anyone ever deserved the greeting in heaven, "Well done, thou good and faithful servant," it was my Mother. She was a woman after God's own heart.
