



## Don Cram

Don Cram was born in Harris, Saskatchewan, on April 28, 1918. He passed away at Fairfield Park, Wallaceburg, on September 2nd, 2011 at the age of 93 years. Predeceased by his wife Dorothy Cram (2010). Deeply missed by his son David (Ann), and his daughter Elaine Brander, grandsons Alec (Joanna) and Peter Cram and Alan and Evan Brander, and great grandson Isaac Cram. Also predeceased by son-in-law, David Brander (2011) and sister Helen Cram (2005). A prairie boy, Don's character and values were forged by the depression. Hard work and determination led to an engineering degree from the University of Saskatchewan. His career took him from munitions and aircraft work during WWII, to the H.J. Heinz Company in Leamington and Wallaceburg, to Polysar in Sarnia and Antwerp, Belgium, where he was the project manager of a new petrochemical plant. In his retirement, Don touched countless people along the Baseline and beyond with his home baked bread, produce from his garden, and a large variety of machine repairs. In his workshop on the Snye, he produced fine woodworking creations known as 'Cramcraft' for his grandchildren. In the summer Don could often be found in his garden with his portable radio tuned to 'Saturday Afternoon at the Opera'. Visitation will take place at 10 a.m. on September 24 at Trinity United Church, 750 Wellington St., Wallaceburg.
