On Sunday December 21, 2025, Elsie (Elsa) Krahn (nee Klassen) passed away peacefully at her home at the age of 92.

She was a volunteer with Sombra Home Meals for almost 40 years, and she worked for Lambton Elderly Outreach for about 7 years before retiring to enjoy cooking, baking, gardening, daily walks in her community, reading, crocheting, knitting and,

most importantly, family time.

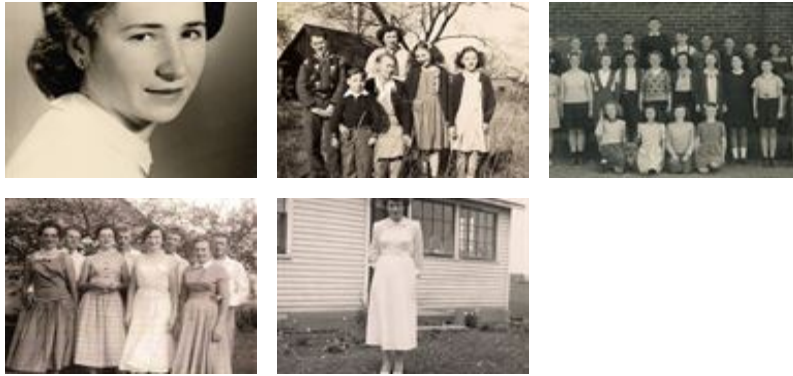
