Gone to his rest on Friday, October 18, 2013 in his 85th year, after a lifetime of hard work and achievement. Surrounded by family and much love at the time of his passing, Gary leaves behind his wife and best friend of 62 years, Marie, and his dearly loved children, Deborah (Bob), Elizabeth and Grady (Trish), as well as his beloved sisters Sally (Jim) and Kathy. Loving Buppa (grandfather) to Paul, Morgan, Larissa, Kyle (predeceased, 1992), Eamon, Conor, Liam, Kelsey and Dana, and great-grandfather to Wesley and Ronan. Predeceased by parents Desmond and Ola, sister Margery and brother Andrew. Among his proudest accomplishments were the founding of the Wallaceburg Courier Press (1972), the founding of the Wallaceburg Sports Hall of Fame (1980), the resurrection of the Baldoon Golf Course (1983), his term as Mayor of Wallaceburg (1988-91) and as Wallaceburg Municipal Councillor (1970), Wallaceburg Kinsmen Club President (1970) and his designation as the first Junior Rotarian ever in Wallaceburg. Gary had a great love for Wallaceburg and served its interests in innumerable ways throughout his life. He was a great man to his last breath – strong and generous, always putting others first and sharing the beauty and humour he saw in life. He will be greatly missed. The family will receive relatives and friends at the HAYCOCK-CAVANAGH FUNERAL HOME, 409 Nelson Street in Wallaceburg from 2-4 & 7-9 PM on Monday. 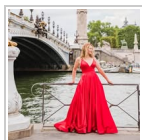

“ *In this very moment, what lays in front of me and ahead, pales in comparison to the flood of memories I now conjure of one my "favourite guys".*

Gary O'Flynn was a beauty, a true original and a man of many loves; above all else, his family, followed by special friends (who were fortunate enough to be invited into his circle), his home town and his Detroit Tigers.

Through the protective haze of his bombast and acerbic persona, be it by pen or mouth, was a man who could humble you with his generosity, inspire you with his encouragement and amaze you with his self-effacing honesty. Perhaps, he was one of the most honest men I have ever encountered.

He was very good to me and he became a cherished friend over time. This may be hard to believe for some folks who followed our editorial sword fights as competitors. We had great fun, the odd public outburst et all. Much of that was pantomime.

His stories were legendary, his opinion was often courageous and he possessed a great wit. He wasn't big on having favours returned, at least to him personally. I discovered that a genuine bit of thoughtfulness extended to one of his family members or a friend of his was best appreciated.

Early in my marriage and after the birth of our third child, my wife and I were looking at moving into a bigger home. We found exactly what we were looking for; a place just a few miles from the town limits, on the bend of 40 highway. We toured the home, started the negotiations and couldn't have been more excited about settling there with our young family.

I eagerly shared my enthusiasm about this opportunity with my friend Gary over coffee one morning. We shared a lot of coffee back then. I described the house, the location and all the amenities. He

didn't say much as I recall, but you could see the wheels turning.

He called me the next day and he couldn't have been more direct or more sincere. "Jesus Weeseey, he said with a tone of great concern, "after our coffee yesterday, I jumped in my truck and I checked-out that house. I just can't get it out of my mind and I didn't sleep. You can't buy that house! It's too close to the highway and you got those beautiful little kids, there's a creek behind the house. Please don't buy it" he pleaded. ...We didn't.

Come on Tigers..let's win this thing for one of your greatest fans. He did his part. Gary O'Flynn was able end his season as a beloved Champion in the league that mattered most to him, his family and community. It wasn't easy for him Lord knows. He had to rally through his personal demons, gut wrenching sorrow and go extra innings in life expectancy. How that man made it to 85 is nothing short of a miracle in itself.

And here's something that impressed me a great deal. He and his wife Marie were able to remain disarmingly modest despite the seismic shifts in personal wealth, earned as a result of taking big gambles in business, all money "placed down:" on the faith of Wallacburgers for support. They didn't let him down.

Oh yeah...there was that wee bit of fortune with a lottery ticket too. And get this.. I still had to take my turn buying his coffee (at the seniors rate) at McDonalds. It reminded of a guy who walked 50 years with a pebble in his shoe and then had the ability to remove it. He still walked with a limp. I suspect they he and Marie were considerably more charitable with their loved ones.

I can only imagine that their hearts are breaking today. Mine is aching.

We lost a good one today.
