



John Martin

May 7, 2020

My dad passed away on May 7, 2020 after a brief battle with cancer, although battle seems like the wrong word, as it felt more like an ambush.

His name is John Stuart Carlyle Martin, but most of you knew him simply as Stoney. Born in Wallaceburg, he passed away just a few months shy of his 70th birthday. Whether you dealt with him for business purposes, or social, he was a man to be reckoned with.

Rugby was his passion, starting at St Andrews College in 1967 after he parted ways with the local high school. At great cost to his continued health and well being, he continued to play the sport he loved for 30 years. During that time, he played for Toronto, London, Sarnia, Barrie, St. Thomas and many more. He even played pick-up games for Newfoundland and South Africa (the latter under the guise of 'a business trip' to which he just so happened to bring his gear.) He played tournaments across Canada and the U.S.

In the early 80's with the help of friends, dad brought rugby to town with the formation of the Wallaceburg Mercenaries Rugby Club, they would play anybody for the party. Years later, long after he stopped playing 'officially', dad was approached by a teacher from WDSS about forming a team and coaching a new generation. As well as coaching for the Tartans, and briefly for the Kent Havoc, he also used his connections with Barbarian Rugby Wear to ensure high school teams across south western Ontario were kitted out in their best at cost.

When he wasn't on the field, dad was working hard to save the family

business. In 1981 he returned to Wallaceburg to take over Martin Insurance Brokers, which he ran up until his 'retirement' in 2015. Not sure what to do with downtime, in his later years, dad took up commercial underwriting for Lambton Mutual Insurance Company. I'm not sure he ever really grasped the idea of hobbies.

During all of this he was continuously working hard for his community, including serving as Wallaceburg Police Commissioner and organizing chili cook offs for the United Way. My dad was ever the idea man, or probably more accurately, the instigator, setting things in motion while content to remain behind the scenes. He wrote speeches for beloved local politicians, and helped to create initiatives like the Adopt-A-Spice program. While my grandfather, Harold Martin was credited with the creation of WAMBO, it was actually born of my dad's idea. He envisioned expanding Grande Old Days to reflect his love of old wooden boats. 'Grande Old Days, Grande Old Boats'. In 1985 and 1986 he produced two boat shows on the south side, with crafts coming in from the states and as far north the Muskokas. That idea combined with grandpa's contacts and charisma turned it into the institution it is today. An avid boater all his life, dad was always happiest on the water, even when he seemed furious, as those of you who remember his time as WAMBO harbour master can attest to. As well, he served many years as boat chairman and beer tent chairman of WAMBO.

John is survived by his wife Sheila, daughter Brander, granddaughter Delilah, estranged sister Marilyn, mother in law Olive, sister in law Jocelyn, and nephews Eric and Joe. He will be missed.

We are very grateful for the outstanding care and compassion exhibited by our entire medical community.

As per John's wishes, there will be no public service. A wake will be held locally once the public health situation allows for it. The Haycock-Cavanagh Funeral Home, 409 Nelson Street in Wallaceburg has been entrusted with the arrangements. Probably not the one we spent many hours skiing and swimming from over 50 years ago, but one very similar to it. I'm sorry, the answer to my message, was not what I expected to see/hear. You see, I believe both John and I graduated from high school in 1967, even though Canada has a grade 13, it would be off to college for both of us soon. But not before we worked together cutting grass on Fawn Island for Herb Thompson and his Dad JL, during those summer months. The days it rained we would build sections of "boardwalk" that would be used to replace rotted ones, and we planted many trees also. There, my Mom & Dad had a summer cottage directly across the canal from his parents Pard & Jean. This is how we met! John's sense of humor was one of a kind, and all 3 of us didn't much care for the French girls in Montreal. They only wanted to dance with themselves!

Being a "yankee" John was very persistent that because I was working in Canada, and living on a Canadian Island for the summers, that I needed to become more Canadian in my daily and nightly activities. Thus, he made me join the Wallaceburg Teen Club, and I went to dances there, when during the slow dances, the couples would actually maneuver around in a circle. Oh well, must be a Canadian thing. John said, now that I was a teen club member, that I had to help with a "Gondola Festival". Now, do they still have that, I know it's been over 50 years, but somethings do seem to go on forever.

Anyway I could go on and on about stories and antics that John and

I did for the few short summers that we worked and played together. We kind of drifted apart when John went to St Andrews College and I went to Central Michigan University. I met my wife, who will celebrate 50 years of marriage this July, and the last time I saw John was at our wedding reception. After the 9/11 disaster, we stopped going to Canada, as it got much harder to come and go, not having a passport. Now we have a passport card and we were all ready to go and look up John one way or the other, then came the Covid-19 pandemic and we still haven't crossed the bridge yet. God Bless you Sheila and Brander, again I only wish I had made connections sooner. Thank you for being in John's life, I am sure glad I got spend a few summers with him. All I have is memories but we will all get to see him again.
