



## Margaret Lauzon

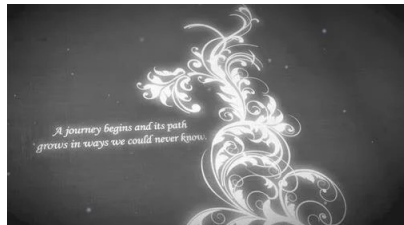

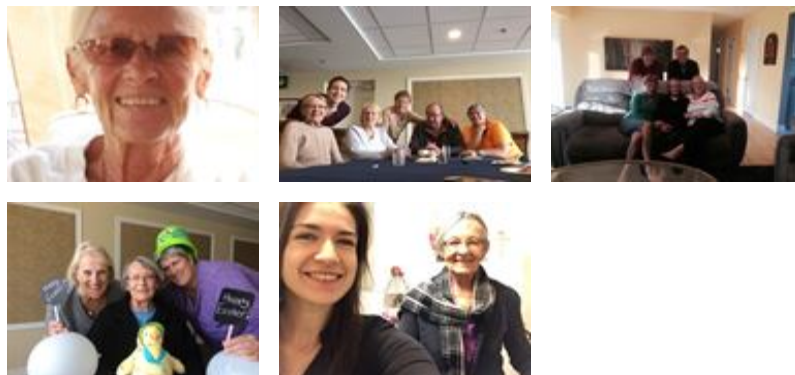
