I remember the Twist contest in Dresden, that she and Robbie Simpson won. She could move that body!!! The apple pie contest we had at our home in London. She swore she made THE best apple pie. Even though Lonnie took a straw to have a piece of her pie since it was so watery, somehow she won!

Whenever I introduced her as my Aunt Pam she would always interject with, "her Favourite Aunt". So many memories. As I visited her at her home and at Fairfield and watched her decline it just shattered me. Her essence and her whole being, was just fading away. I have been an RN for many years. I have worked in ICU and then long term care. I have seen this, helped families deal with this exact same situation but this has been different and my heart hurts so much. I am not sure why so much, I mean I have lost both parents, three brothers in law, a nephew, cousins and close friends in the course of 6 years. They all hurt but for whatever reason this death has knocked on my butt. However, I do want to thank Jack for finding her again and treating her like a queen. She could be grumpy with him but it not deter him from loving her. Thank you
