Raymond George Humphrey, a long time resident of Wallaceburg, passed away on Wednesday, January 16, 2013, in Chatham, at the age of 69 years. Ray was the son of the late George and Millie Humphrey. A loving father to his sons; Bill and his wife Theresa, Paul and his wife Angie, Don and his wife Lauri; and to his daughter, Terri; he was also the cherished grandfather of Justin, Hayden, Gregory and Nathan.
