He had his life and ,well, I was still in school and we didn't have much in common. He did become the big brother once I was able to go out (I wasn't allowed to have a boyfriend) but we did go to the same CBD Club in Chatham. I met a few young men but Bob was always the one who drove me home because my dad was waiting for me to be home at midnight sharp, and, since I could not go or come home with a boy Bob was my go between.....Time space... I always managed to come home with Bob on time so I wouldn't get in trouble with my dad.. Bob didn't like this arrangement but HE was my big brother and did not want me to get in trouble. Bob always defied dad and helped me out. Then in 1959 I went away to teachers' college and Bob went his way. We lost the connection we had (which wasn't that strong but it was there, weak, but there. I got a job north of Grand Bend, became my own woman, met someone very special and got married and remained north of Chatham. A year or so later Bob married Margie and started a family. Our friendship ignited and continued again. As the years continued the bro/sis friendship continued to grow a little stronger as time went on. Once we were in a good place it was time to say "goodbye". Bob you were a good big brother. When I reminisce of our growing up years, they were pretty damn good. Good bye dear brother, love you and will miss you dearly.
