SAMUEL SOVEREIGN DUNSEITH of Port Lambton, at Fairfield Park in Wallaceburg on April 8, 2013 in his 93rd year. Born February 17, 1921, the son of Letha Cole (1887-1964 & John Hunter Dunseith (1887-1967). He is the last surviving member of the Dunseith family of eight children having been predeceased by Pete, Tom, Kelly, Betty, Jack, Brian & Deirdre. Survived by his wife of 35 years, Grace Dunseith, step son Darrell Randell and his wife Nancy, his special grandchildren, Rachel McDonald and her Husband Mike of Corunna, Barry Randell of Petrolia, Ben and Colleen Randell of Windsor, and two very special great grandsons, Jack Randell and Owen McDonald. He is also survived by his nephew John Dunseith and his wife Carol of Sarnia and many other nieces and great nieces and nephews. Sam was a WWII veteran in the RCAF having served as a rear gunner in 18 Lancaster missions over occupied Europe before being shot down over St Laurent de Bois in France. He was a member of RCL Branch 18 in Wallaceburg. Sam worked with his family as Dunseith Bros. Construction near Woodstock for many years as well as farming there. He eventually came to Sombra Township as Road Superintendent in 1974 until his retirement in 1986. He served as municipal councilor for two terms in Sombra Township until 1994. The family will receive relatives and friends at the HAYCOCK-CAVANAGH FUNERAL HOME, 409 Nelson Street in Wallaceburg from 7-9 PM on Tuesday with a Legion Service at 7 PM.
